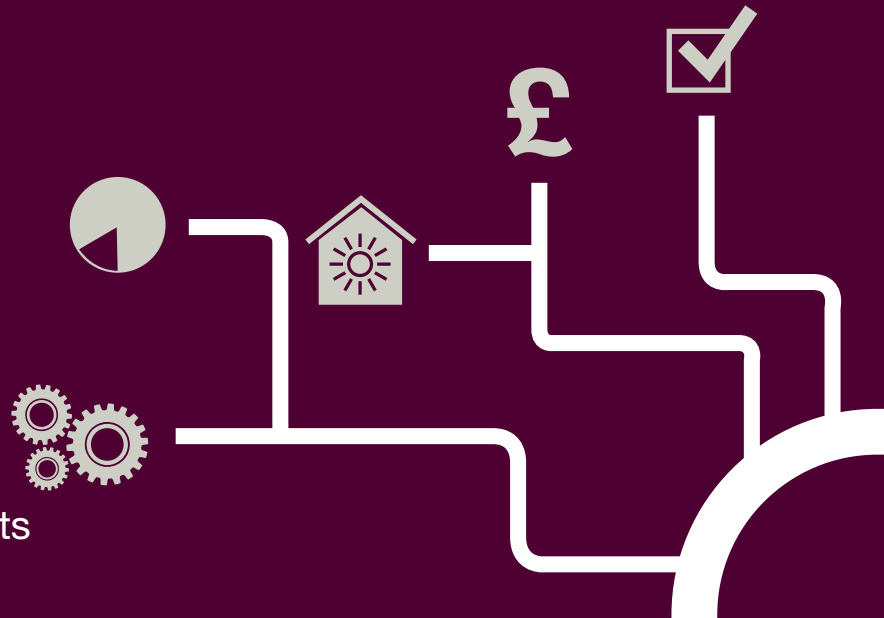


Funding and support for local bioenergy development in the West Midlands
